

Care Instructions for Indoor Furniture

By the time you receive your furniture, we have applied a protective barrier of finish. Please feel free to put your piece directly into use.

Water will not hurt your furniture, so feel free to use a damp cloth to wipe away any dust and debris which collects.

If you need to use a cleanser, mix a light dish detergent with lukewarm water. Apply this solution with a soft rag or sponge. Use clean water and rinse with a soft rag or sponge to remove soap residue. Finally, wipe the piece dry with a clean soft rag.

Some cleaning products, such as Pledge or Glo, have silicone in them which can hamper the process of refinishing at a future date. We do not recommend their use.

Clay products such as pottery or plates have a raw edge on the bottom which can scratch the finish. Using placemats and coasters will further protect your furniture's surface.

Small scratches and dents show up as we use furniture. If you experience a more drastic situation, please feel free to contact us and we can give you recommendations on how to address damage.

Tables are finished with a water-based polyurethane and chairs with an oil-based urethane. We use products from General Finishes.

With proper care and use, your furniture will last lifetimes.
