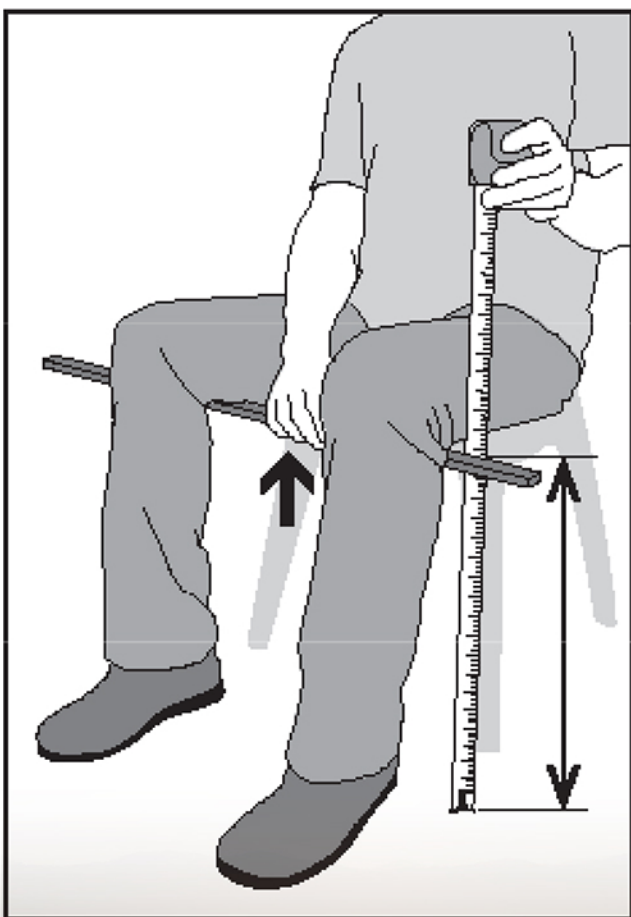




Measuring Leg Height

The Sonus is a beautifully articulated expression of comfort specifically designed to benefit the physical health of musicians, born of collaboration with musicians and three decades of ergonomic study. The size, angle and height of the back, the pitch of the seat and the round shapes all support the movements and posture that musicians need.



The height of your Sonus will be customized to your dimensions, which we need your help measuring.

1. Take a seat wearing shoes that you would normally play or practice in (or even barefoot if you normally play barefoot).
2. With your feet resting flat on the floor, bring a straight edge (like a yardstick) gently against the backs of your thighs. Do not press too firmly.
3. Use a measuring tape to measure the distance between the floor and the straight edge's contact point with your thighs. Do not round up or down to a whole number; measure to the nearest 1/8th of an inch.
